Meeting summary

UKPN and the SPN group met to introduce the SPN region. This meeting included:

- (i) An overview of the investment and network planning process with worked examples of this in practice across SPN;
- (ii) Key overviews and summaries of the SPN region, including the regions challenges, data, businesses, performance, engagement to date and examples of how these will be supported within SD2;
- (iii) Regional deep dives with detailed overview and work-throughs of the investments and growth being supported by UKPN within SPN; and
- (iv) A detailed overview of the makeup of vulnerability within the region.

Discussion

Key discussions and steer focused around:

(i) Discussion around the potential key challenges and changes the region might see to strategic planning, development and vulnerability across ED2;

- (ii) Discussion around the use of customer segmentation and specific SPN considerations around stakeholders within the network planning process;
- (iii) Steer to provide additional information around local level developments and the interaction with UKPN to the CEG;
- (iv) Discussion on the extent to which network planning and the strategic investment process considers regional stakeholder findings within the investment process; and
- (v) Steer from the group on the use of vulnerability data within the network planning process.

Actions and next steps

Action – UKPN to share regional development plans with CEG.

Action – UKPN to offer to spend time with CEG and network planning leads to run through key regional themes, processes and information around SPN.

Action – UKPN to investigate how to provide more information on local level developments to the CEG.

Action – UKPN to review if there is data on the proportion / rates of curtailment and use of active network management.

Action – UKPN to give an overview of the delivery partners or accommodate other requests around vulnerability support and how vulnerability feeds into other areas of UKPN.

Action – UKPN to share updated complains data within the engagement catalogue.

Action – UKPN to investigate regional complaints data to see if this can be sent to the CEG.

Action – UKPN to ensure CEG have opportunity to engage with vulnerability data.
